Featured Project:

South Dakota State University Jackrabbit Village

Muth Electric was awarded the electrical contract for the latest housing project, Jackrabbit Village, on the South Dakota State University campus in Brookings, SD. Work on this 205,000 square foot facility began in April 2012 with an expected completion date of July 2013.

Located in the southeast living community, the four new residence halls that make up Jackrabbit Village will house 800 freshman and sophomore students. Seventy-five percent of the facilities are traditional, double occupancy rooms for freshman housing. The other 25% are four, six or eight person suites for sophomore housing. The housing is grouped into pods of 30-36 students. This allows opportunities to create 24 unique communities. Amenities for each pod include a kitchen and living room area, study space, laundry and restroom facilities that provide greater privacy. The suites have private restrooms within each unit.

This project will allow all the freshman and sophomore students to be housed on the southeast corner of the campus. This is part of the second phase of SDSU's housing and dining services master plan.

Also, all of the facilities have an increase in square footage per occupant compared to the existing facilities. One of the new halls will house the Honors College offices and classroom; thereby creating an honors living community that provides greater interaction between student life and academics.

The general contractor on this project is Sioux Falls Construction of Sioux Falls, SD. Koch-Hazard Ar-

chitects of Sioux Falls, SD, Treanor Architects of Lawrence, KS and Confluence Landscape Architect of Sioux Falls, SD are the architects. The engineers are Associated Consulting Engineering Incorporated, Structural Engineering Associates, and Banner Consulting Engineers and Architects, all of Sioux Falls, SD.

Gary Swier is the Project Manager, Lane Hammond is the Project Foreman and Jared Schmidt is

the Project Estimator. 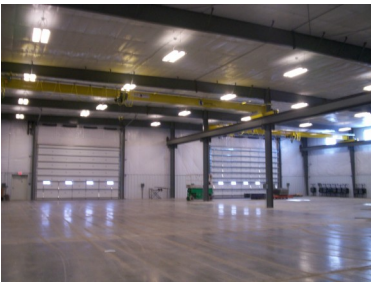

Common Sense Manufacturing

Muth Electric began wiring the 28,000 square foot Common Sense Manufacturing facility in Faulkton, SD in August 2012. The facility was completed in February 2013.

Common Sense Manufacturing produces farm equipment such as bale feeders, calf shelters, bottomless bunks, and solar water pumps.



The main part of the shop is set up with center columns that allow for two sixty foot bays for the hoist system. There are five individual bridge cranes for unloading trucks and work stations. The facility also includes an office area



with several offices, conference room, a break room with a full kitchen, and three restrooms.

Two unique elements of this project are the hoist system and the electric in-floor heating system that uses cable instead of the conventional pex and boiler system. There are also two electric furnaces for the office and break room area.

GA Johnson Construction was the general contractor for this project.

Jim Kramp was the **Project Manager**, **Aaron Dosch** was the **Project Foreman**, and **Jim Norgaard** was the **Project Estimator**.
